Giulia Dell’Asin is a transportation engineer working since 2011 with the Swiss Federal Railways (SBB CFF FFS).

She holds a M.Sc. in Civil Engineering from the Technical University of Turin (2008) and a Ph.D. in Transportation Engineering from the Technical University of Madrid (2014).

At SBB CFF FFS, she worked as Project Manager for civil engineering projects (railway bridges and railway noise mitigation) and as Specialist in railway timetable planning. She is currently working as Specialist in **Railway Station Accessibility** with a focus on pedestrian flows and human behavior.

Her research focuses on the quality of service at transport interchanges, passengers intermodality and mobility surveys. In this field, she has contributed to EU projects such as the COST Action 358 “*Pedestrian Quality Needs*” (2006) and HERMES Project “*High Efficient and Reliable arrangeMEnts for CroSsmodal Transport*” (2011).

In 2014 she took part in the UIC SIAFInternational Programme and is now a member of the UIC “Global Network of Railway Talents” project.
