

Summary biography for MIKE GOGGIN

Mike Goggin is a Director with independent transport consultants Steer Davies Gleave where is also a member of its Executive Management Team. He is now responsible for supporting the company's development of its international advisory offer in transport policy, investments and transactions and he continues to support the company's numerous projects on franchising, stations and transport interchanges in the UK and overseas.

His recent work in regard to railway stations and interchanges has included developing a vision for stations for the UK's Rail Delivery Group. Mike has also supported them in leading a review of the potential implications on station and on-train retailing as a result of the changing nature of retailing in the UK. He has worked on commissions for Network Rail, franchise owners, Department for Transport, Transport for London, Passenger Transport Executives and financial investors.

Internationally Mike has worked on assignments in Canada, the USA, Saudi Arabia, mainland Europe, Mexico and Brazil. The work has included the introduction of open access arrangements to the Brazilian rail network, the redevelopment of five of the USA's largest railroad stations and the development of four new high-speed rail stations in Saudi Arabia.

From 2010 until his return to SDG in 2012 Mike was Director, Stations & Customer Service for Network Rail. This new role was created to support the organisation's development and coordination of its plans for the management of the UK's 2,500 railway stations. During his time with the company it established design guidance for stations, published a report on the economic value of stations and undertook a pedestrian capacity assessment for its station estate.

Mike's broader experience includes time with a bus company, rail freight and leading the busy day-to-day operation of the rail network in Kent and South East London.

Mike is a Chartered Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Transport and Logistics, a Fellow of the Institute of Railway Operators and a MBA.
